

New York State Boating Safety Course

This course enables persons age 10 and above to be licensed to operate motor boats and persons above age 14 to operate personal watercraft in New York waters. Upon taking the course and passing the test, students will receive their certification. This is a serious course with a difficult multiple choice exam. Children under age 15 do best if accompanied by an older sibling or adult. Attendance at all classes is required to pass. A parent or guardian of a minor must come to the first hour of the course and give permission for the minor to attend.
