

Supply Lists for 2016-17

Pre-K and K

- 2 boxes of tissues
- Three packs of Crayola crayons no larger than 24 crayons Crayola only please for true colors!
- 2 wire bound notebooks (50 pages or more) Please write your child's name on the front cover. Feel free to pick notebooks with kid friendly designs!
- 4 Two-pocket folders to be kept in book bag for daily mail (Label)
- or 2 plastic folders (they last longer!)
- Full size Backpack/book bag
- 1 container of baby wipes
- Sneakers for gym class and recess; needed daily
- Complete change of clothes (please put in a plastic bag, with each item labeled)
- Old, large shirt for art class
- Napping blanket or beach towel for rest time held in a cloth shopping bag (No sleeping bags please)

Please bring all supplies on the first day of school. Please write your child's name on everything!

First Grade Supply List

- pencils
- erasers
- a zippered pencil case
- a box of gluesticks-labeled with your child's name
- box of crayons-24 or less
- sneakers for gym
- a large book bag to carry items home every night and for snow clothes in the winter
- 1 subject notebook, with your child's name on it
- Second Grade Supply List

Second Grade Supply List

- 2 boxes of pencils

- 2 boxes of glue sticks
- 1 pencil bag or crayon box

Third Grade Supply List

Please have your child bring the following items on the first day of school with their name on everything.

- 1 regular sized single subject notebook
- 1 ruler with inches and cm
- 2 boxes of crayons (no markers please)
- pencils and erasers
- 1 pencil box for desk (boxes can hold more than the bags)
- 1 pair of scissors for construction paper
- 10 clear or white glue sticks
- 1 small pencil sharpener with cover to have at your desk
- 1 highlighter
- 1 book bag

One laminated 2-pocket folder or plastic coated 2-pocket folder that will go back and forth each night for your homework, notes, and graded papers. They usually have animals or colorful designs on *them*.

Fourth Grade Supply List

- A sturdy folder for homework
- Loose leaf paper in a folder
- Pencils and erasers
- Glue or glue sticks
- 2 Containers of disinfecting wipes
- Zippered bag for pencils

Fifth Grade Supply List

- 1 file folder with at least five compartments (the envelope style)
- 2 pens (any color is fine) to be refilled as needed
- 1 package of Post-It notes
- 2 fine line dry erase markers
- pencils and erasers to be refilled as needed
- an old sock to be used as a white board eraser

Sixth Grade Recommended Supplies

- Loose-leaf paper
- plastic pencil case
- 3 spiral notebooks (one spiral notebook with three or more dividers is fine)
- #2 pencils and red pens (s)
- Book covers for all books (paper bags are fine)
- Crayons, colored pencils, or thin line markers
- scissors
- 1 box of tissues
- Blue or black pens
- Expandable file folders (containing at least 7 pockets, can be found at Walmart, Grand Union, or Sta-ples)

7th and 8th Grade Art: A folder and pencil to be left in class

Studio Art, Drawing and Painting, and Art Appreciation: A sketchbook (preferably spiral bound), folder, and pencil to be left in class

7th, 8th & 9th Grade Science: Note Book Pencil (NO PENS) 3-Ring binder with dividers

English, Mrs. Behm

- Pens and pencils, spiral notebook or a section of a binder dedicated to English, folder with

pockets, marble note-book (unless Mrs. Behm still has your marble notebook from last year)

- 12th grade and College English: Pens and pencils, spiral notebook or a section of a binder dedicated to English, folder with pockets, small (1" or 3") 3-ring binder, plain tabs for the binder, flash drive

Social Studies, Ms. Corey

All social studies classes grades 10-12 will need the following supplies:

- One 1.5" 3-ring binder (used for social studies only)
